

# UAL LEVEL 3 DIPLOMA OR EXTENDED IN PERFORMING AND PRODUCTION ARTS - DANCE

ONE - TWO YEARS



## What you'll need

We ask all our applicants to have five GCSE's between grades four to nine, ideally these will include music, maths and english. We'd also like you to have experience from a dance school or have a GCSE in dance.

We also want you to demonstrate a passion for performing arts. If you apply, we'll invite you to an interview and audition.

## What you'll learn

You have the option to choose a one-year Diploma that's the equivalent of 1.5 A-Levels, or a two-year Extended Diploma that's the equivalent to 3 A-Levels.

Over each of these courses we'll equip you with new skills and techniques to develop as a performer, across a wide range of performances throughout the curriculum.

Each course will give you experience in ballet technique, tap, contemporary dance, urban, jazz, dance improvisation and choreography, group and individual repertoire, and musical theatre.



## How are you assessed?

This course is modular, so each assessment will involve performances and coursework. While we assess you on rehearsals, practical performance and written coursework, in the lead up to that we make sure to give you a complete brief for each project with a clear outline and it's content.

You will need to put in some time for independent research, and rehearsals towards performances and projects. But, your tutors bring with them a wealth of industry knowledge, so they'll be with you every step of the way for advice and guidance - and to bring out the best potential performer in you!
